Family Camping

Family Camping is one of most popular pack activities, and takes place over 2 weekends each year at one of our nearby scout camps.

The next Family Campout is the weekend of May 14-16, and will take place at Camp Winnebago (off Route 80 near Rockaway Mall). Our pack often has 20+ families attend.

Family Campouts are for the entire family (if you want), or just a parent and a cub scout, or anywhere in between. Siblings (boys and girls) and all parents are welcome to attend. Most activities can be done by siblings. Some families bring everyone, some families treat it as a mom/son or dad/son weekend; it's up to you.

The main campout activities take place Saturday, from 8am to 8pm, with BB guns, archery, row boats, fishing derby, crafts, reptile shows, etc, with a big campout-wide campfire and show starting around 7pm.

Many people come and camp out both Friday and Saturday nights, but many other people arrive early Saturday and stay just one night. You can also just come for the day to try it out (but arrive early)!

Our pack will be cooking Saturday breakfast, Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast. There is a hot dog sale Saturday for lunch, but if you don't like hot dogs bring a sandwich or something to cook on your own back at our campsite. **Because of our great popcorn sales this year, P4 will be supplying the food for our three main meals free of charge to you!** Bring your own snacks and drinks, and remember, no food in the tents!
